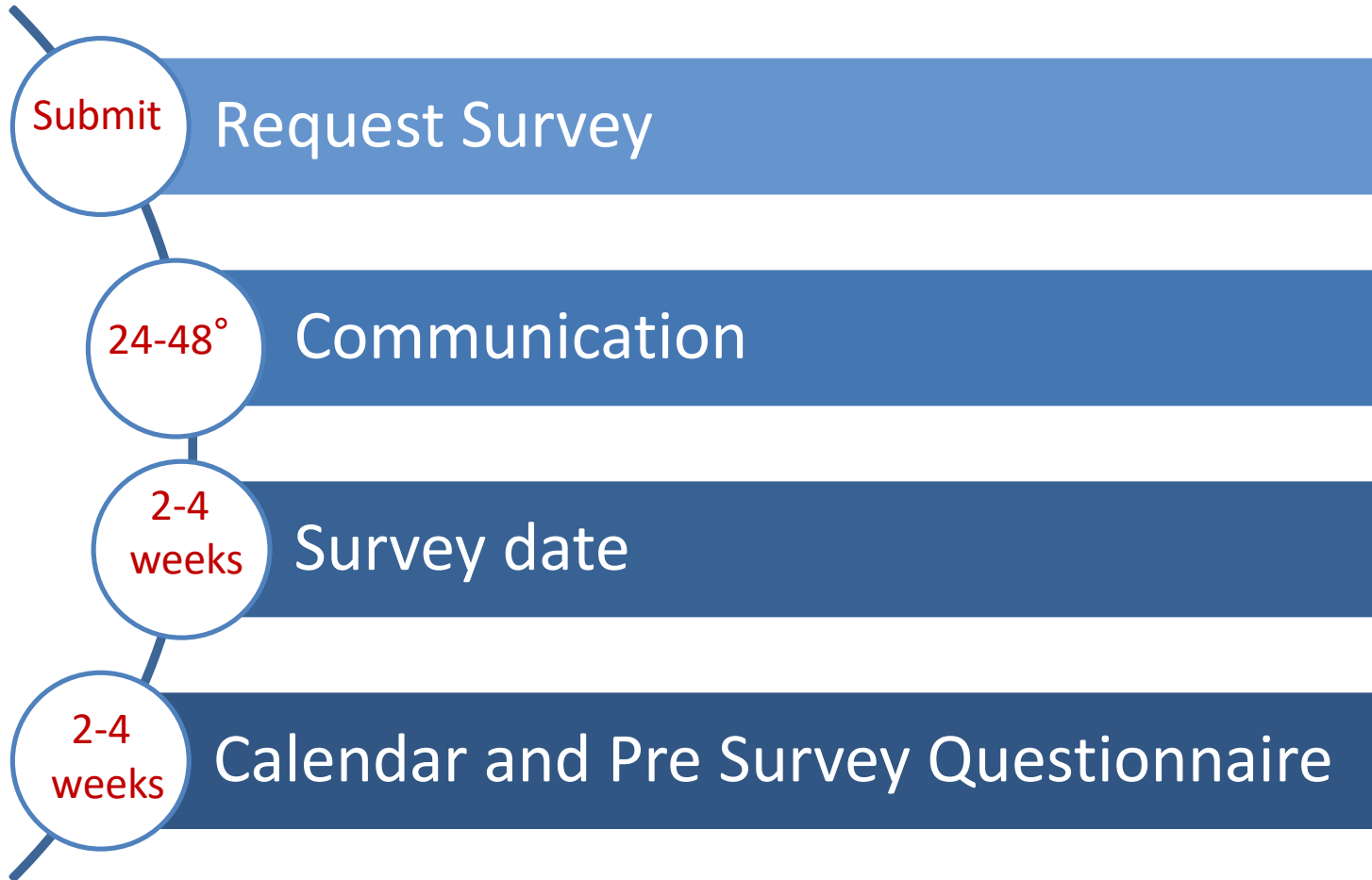

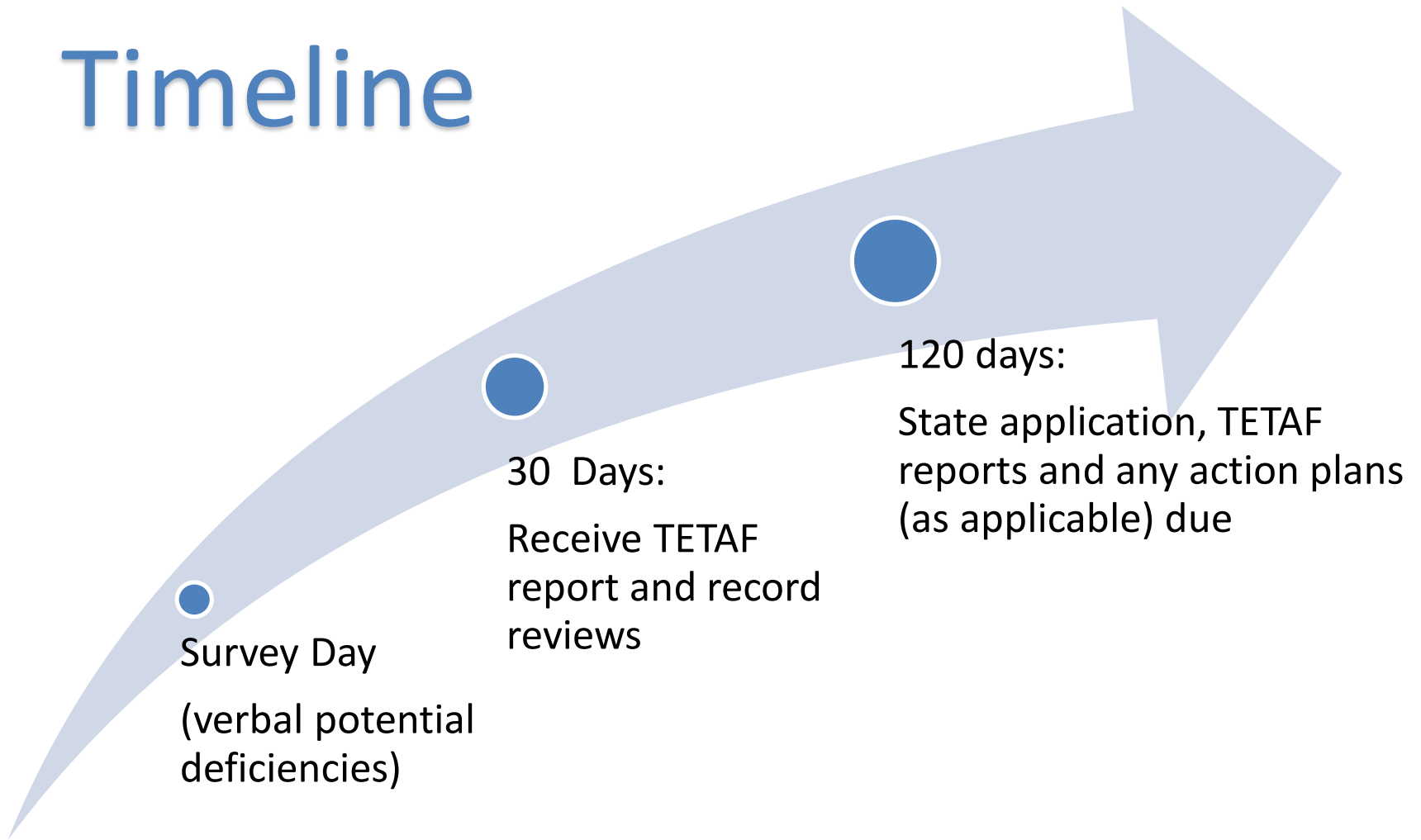

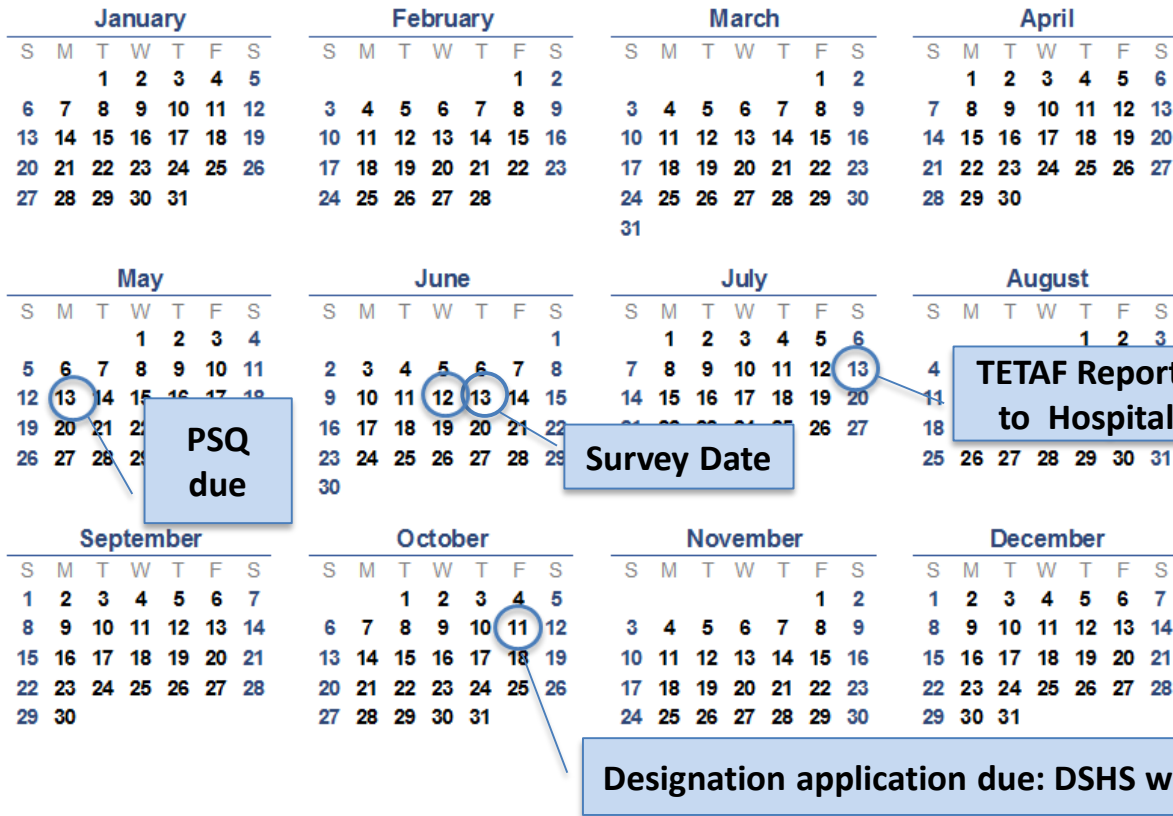

Designation Application Packet

- The applicant shall submit the packet that includes the following documents to the Office of EMS/Trauma Systems (office) within 120 days of the facility's survey date:

Appeal timeline: Rule § 133.204

- Appeal in writing not later than 60 days after issuance of the level determination to the director of the office.
- The written appeal must include a signed letter from the facility's governing board with an explanation of how the facility meets the requirements for the designation level.
- (1) If the office upholds its original determination, the director of the office will give written notice of such to the facility not later than 30 days of its receipt of the applicant's complete written appeal.
- (2) The facility may, not later than 30 days of the office's sending written notification of its denial, submit a written request for further review. Such written appeal shall then go to the director of the office.
